Brainstorming Workshop (Feb 7, 2019, 7pm)

- All students in Grades K-5 are eligible to participate.
- A special format is available for students in Grades K&1
- and...prizes will be awarded to Grade 5 participants who wish to enter the competition.*

Grades K&1 students can choose to do an in-depth study of a particular theme. Each student selects a theme, designs & conducts a study, then presents the results.

An example is:

Theme: The Great Pacific Garbage Patch

Question: What causes the Great Pacific Garbage Patch?

Demonstration: Build a water model showing how water currents might cause a garbage patch.

Record Observations: Draw a picture, take a photo, or present the actual model results.

Present the results (data) at the fair!

Grades 2–5 students and those in Grades K&1 who choose to, will complete a standard science fair investigation. This includes each student asking a testable question, stating a hypothesis, conducting trials & analyzing data.

An example is:

Question: What affects how long a top spins?

Hypothesis: Initial speed, spinning surface, shape of top, top weight. Experiments: Performance of tops differing in one property are compared.

Record observations: Duration of spinning is measured.

Present the results (data) at the fair!

1. Think about a topic you would like to explore. Take inspiration from the world around you. Think about our recent weather or recent science topics in the news. There are a tremendous number of ideas available online. We will have an evening of brainstorming on Feb 7, 2019!

- **3.** Design a science project according to the format described in the Science Fair packet that will be distributed when we receive your form. Make sure to check off which format you will be following.
- 4. Gather materials & fill out the study/investigation organizer found in the Science Fair packet.
- **5.** Presentation Boards will be provided free of charge to all participants. These boards will be distributed at school (details to follow).
